1. How to build a team
 - a. Recruit through persuasive motivation (约 1: 32-51)
 - b. Overcome character flaws
 - 马太=利未 (太 9: 9-13; 可 2:14)
 - Nathan – 巴多罗买 (约 1: 47-50)
 - 彼得=西门= 矶法 (约 13: 6-9; 21: 15-19)
 - 约翰 (约 13: 23; 19: 26-27)
 - c. Get people engaged (喂饱五千人 - 约 6: 5-13; 打鱼交税 - 太 17: 24-27)
 - d. Care for loyal cadres (太 17: 1-9; 约 14: 1-4; 17: 6-19)
2. How to develop team concept among those with diverse backgrounds
 - a. Build shared vision and purpose (约 16: 25-30)
 - b. Establish the belief of attitudes supersedes skills (路 18: 18-30)
 - c. Facilitate growth of the members – 约翰 (路 9: 49-50)
 - d. Use directive, corrective, supportive, and empowerment messages (可 8: 32-33; 约 16: 29-33; 太 28: 17-20)
